4 CANINE MEASUREMENTS



Head length

Measure from level of medial canthus equidistant between eyes to external occipital protuberance.

Front leg length

Measure from proximal edge of central foot pad to point of elbow (olecranon process). Carpus must be straight.

Head circumference

Measure circumference by placing tape equidistant between eyes and ears at widest part of head.

Hind leg length

Measure from proximal edge of central foot pad to tip of hock (dorsal tip of calcaneal process). Tarsus must be straight.
